


SurgeArrest SurgeStation

The SurgeArrest SurgeStation has all the features of the SurgeArrest. Plus, we've made improvements based on suggestions from our customers.

For example, we increased the spacing between outlets so you can hold up to six transformer blocks, or three blocks without covering other outlets.

There are also two outlets that are always on for devices that require constant power. The two outlets supply conditioned power directly from the utility source.

The master on/off switch is easily accessible, but recessed to prevent an accidental turn-off.

The Professional SurgeStation has the same features as the Network SurgeStation, but the Network version features an even stricter IEEE Let-Through rating of <40 V, and the Professional features a rating of <85V. The IEEE tests simulate severe surge

events common to home and office environments.

The Network SurgeStation has additional features including built-in 100BASE-TX, 10BASE-T, and Token Ring protection to prevent surges from damaging connected LAN equipment. It also has cord-management straps that allow power cords to be neatly bundled, and put out of the way.

Also keep in mind the features of the SurgeArrest that are now in the SurgeStation:

- Catastrophic Event
 Protection. When most surge suppressors fail, they still allow harmful "after shock" surges to pass through. If SurgeStation fails, it fails open, preventing subsequent surges from reaching your equipment.
- Industry Approvals. All models carry UL and CSA safety approval.

- 8-Outlet Floor Models. Eight outlets on the floor models provide ample space for equipment plugs with transformer blocks.
- Protection Working Indicator. An LED warns you if the SurgeStation circuitry is damaged. APC will then replace it for free.
- Building/Site Wiring Fault Indicator. This LED identifies dangerous wiring problems before you plug in your equipment.

With a Lifetime Product Warranty, if the SurgeStation gets damaged by a surge or lightning strike we'll replace it for free.

In addition, a \$25,000 Lifetime Equipment Protection policy ensures that equipment connected to the SurgeStation is protected, too!
