

Presenter's Mouse



The Presenter's Mouse is a portable, plug-and-play, hand-held mouse that works either in place of or in conjunction with a standard serial or touchpad mouse. The Mouse gives you full-function cursor control via a top-mount joystick, and it also includes primary and secondary mouse button control. It features an ergonomic palm-fit design and includes a 6-ft. (1.8-m) cord.

Before you install the Presenter's Mouse, please make sure your system fits these requirements: An IBM® compatible laptop or desktop PC with Windows® 95, 98, NT 4.0, or 2000; a PS/2® mouse port.

WARNING

Always turn the computer off before connecting or disconnecting your Presenter's Mouse.


To install the Presenter's Mouse:

1. Turn your computer off.

2. Locate an available 6-pin round mouse port (PS/2) on your computer.
3. Insert the Presenter's Mouse connector into the round mouse port.
4. Start your computer.

NOTE

Depending on your system configuration, the Presenter's Mouse may disable other pointing devices when in use.

If using Windows 95, 98, or 2000:

1. Click **Start**, select **Settings**, then select **Control Panel**.
2. Click on **Add New Hardware**.
3. Follow the instructions in the **Add New Hardware Wizard**.
4. If no Plug and Play devices are found, then select the hardware type **Mouse**.
5. Click on **Standard Mouse Types** and select **Standard PS/2 Port Mouse**.
6. Complete the instructions in the **Add New Hardware Wizard**.

If using Windows NT:

1. Click **Start**, select **Settings**, then select **Control Panel**.
2. Click on **Mouse** and select **General** in **Mouse Properties**.
3. Click **Change** and select **Show All Devices**.
4. Click on **Standard Mouse Types** and select **Standard PS/2 Port Mouse**.
5. Restart the computer.

NOTE

The Presenter's Mouse is designed for use with a PS/2 port only. Using a PS/2 to Serial adapter is not guaranteed to work.
